Targets young children typically 4–13 years old in need of support to reduce emotional, cognitive and behavioral problems. It provides powerful methods to restore children to their highest level of functioning. In our simulated social setting for up to 4 hours 5 days per week. The goal is to reintegrate our young friends back into their home or community based setting.





One-On-One Sessions

Include peer-to-peer support and assistance to develop self advocacy. Personalized sessions include: individual encouragement, self-advocacy, self-direction training, and peer modeling.



Role Playing

Scripted and unscripted puppet shows, dress-up, role reversal, and make believe to practice new behaviors and share personal feelings in a fun way.



Peer Play Groups

Learning to share experiences and feelings through group play. These self-guided and self-healing groups are for children to communicate through games, physical activities, athletics, and team play.




Art & Music Expression

Our Logo Means



Red: Impulse Control/Attending to Tasks

Learn to stop, think, listen, wait patiently, sit still and process before acting out. Stopping urges to follow danger, start fires, or run away. Eliminating impulses to touch others.



Blue: Anger Management/Anxiety Control

Remaining calm like a blue ocean! Learn and apply new coping skills to handle frustrations and disappointments with patience and positive outlets. Eliminating verbal and physical aggression, destroying property,



Yellow: Socializing/Communication

Happy smiley face yellow is about socializing, interacting with peers without arguing, name calling, or vulgar words, and having fun. Attracting friendships and keeping them using kind words and mutual respect.



Green: Depression/Expressing Feelings

Green light go! Time to feel good about one's self, explore the world, and have a positive outlook on life. Learn to open up, share feelings, set goals, and focus on personal happiness.


